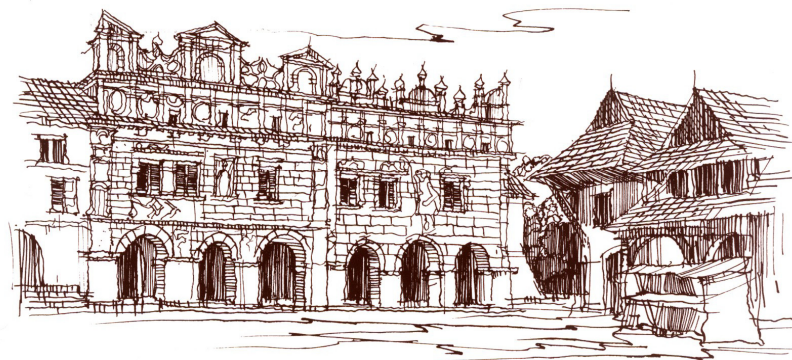

CONFERENCE SITE

The ION 2006 Conference will be held at the “Dom Dziennikarza” hotel in Kazimierz Dolny. The hotel, which is the accommodation place for most of the participants, is situated within a walking distance from the town’s center. Full board, including breakfasts, lunches and evening meals will be served at the hotel restaurant.

The registration of ION 2006 participants will start on Monday, June 26 at 10:00 a.m. in the “Dom Dziennikarza” hotel. The lunch is planned at 13:00 p.m. and the Conference opening at 15:00 p.m. The Conference will be closed with a lunch on Thursday, June 29. Those who wish to come to Kazimierz Dolny earlier or to stay there after the Conference, will be informed by the Organizers on hotel costs.

PROCEEDINGS

All refereed and accepted papers presented at the Conference will be published as a special volume of VACUUM – Surface Engineering, Surface Instrumentation & Vacuum Technology journal. We kindly request the authors to prepare manuscripts using the enclosed Vacuum Instructions to Authors. Invited papers must not exceed 6 Journal pages. Contributed (oral and poster) papers must not exceed 4 pages. Please follow these guidelines: 4 Vacuum pages are equivalent to 2600 words. 6 Vacuum pages are equivalent to 3900 words. One table or figure is equivalent to 150 words. For example, a contributed paper containing 5 figures: 1850 words + 5 figures = 2600 = 4 printed pages in Vacuum. The paper (original plus two copies) with a 3,5” floppy disk should be provided to the Conference Office during the registration.

ABSTRACTS

One page abstract should be clearly typed on a single sheet of paper using the format of Abstract Example enclosed. The abstracts should be submitted by e-mail to ION2006@tytan.umcs.lublin.pl or send by air-mail with a floppy disk to the Conference Secretariat.

POSTERS

Posters should be prepared for a board of the size: 100 cm high × 80 cm wide. The text and figures should be easily read from a distance of 1,5 m.

Important: only papers presented at the Conference will be published.

Abstracts, posters and manuscripts must be in English.
